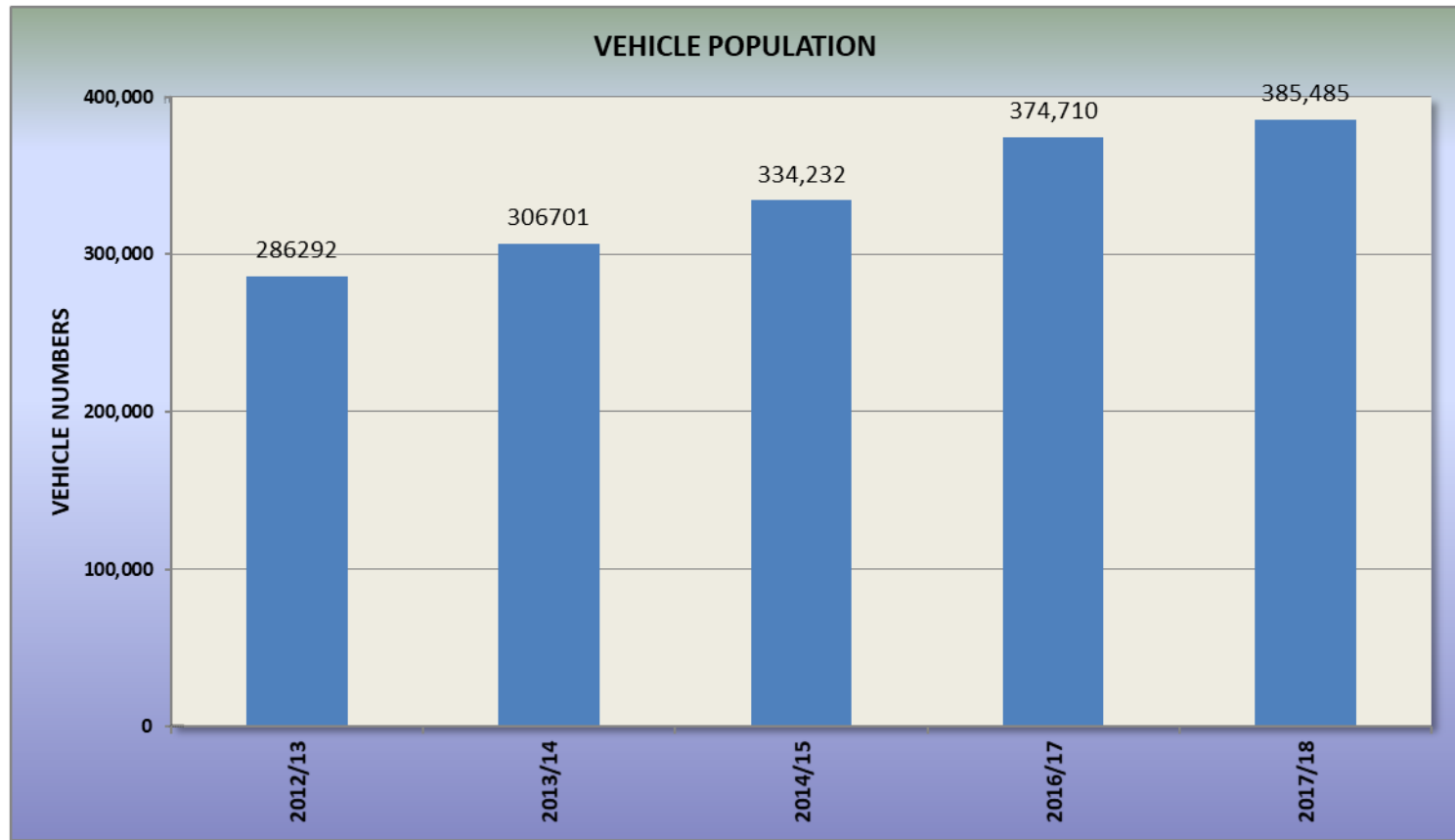

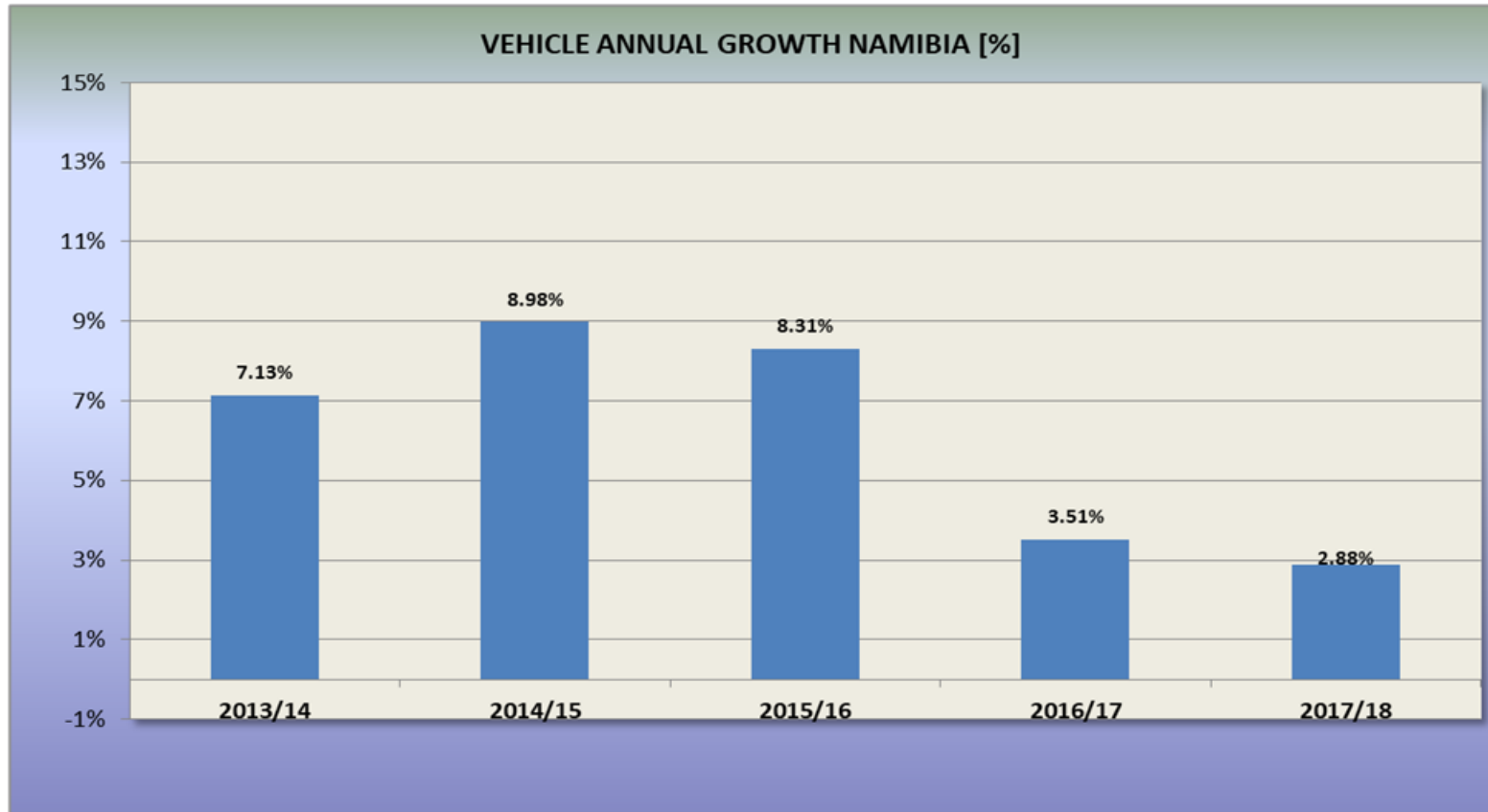

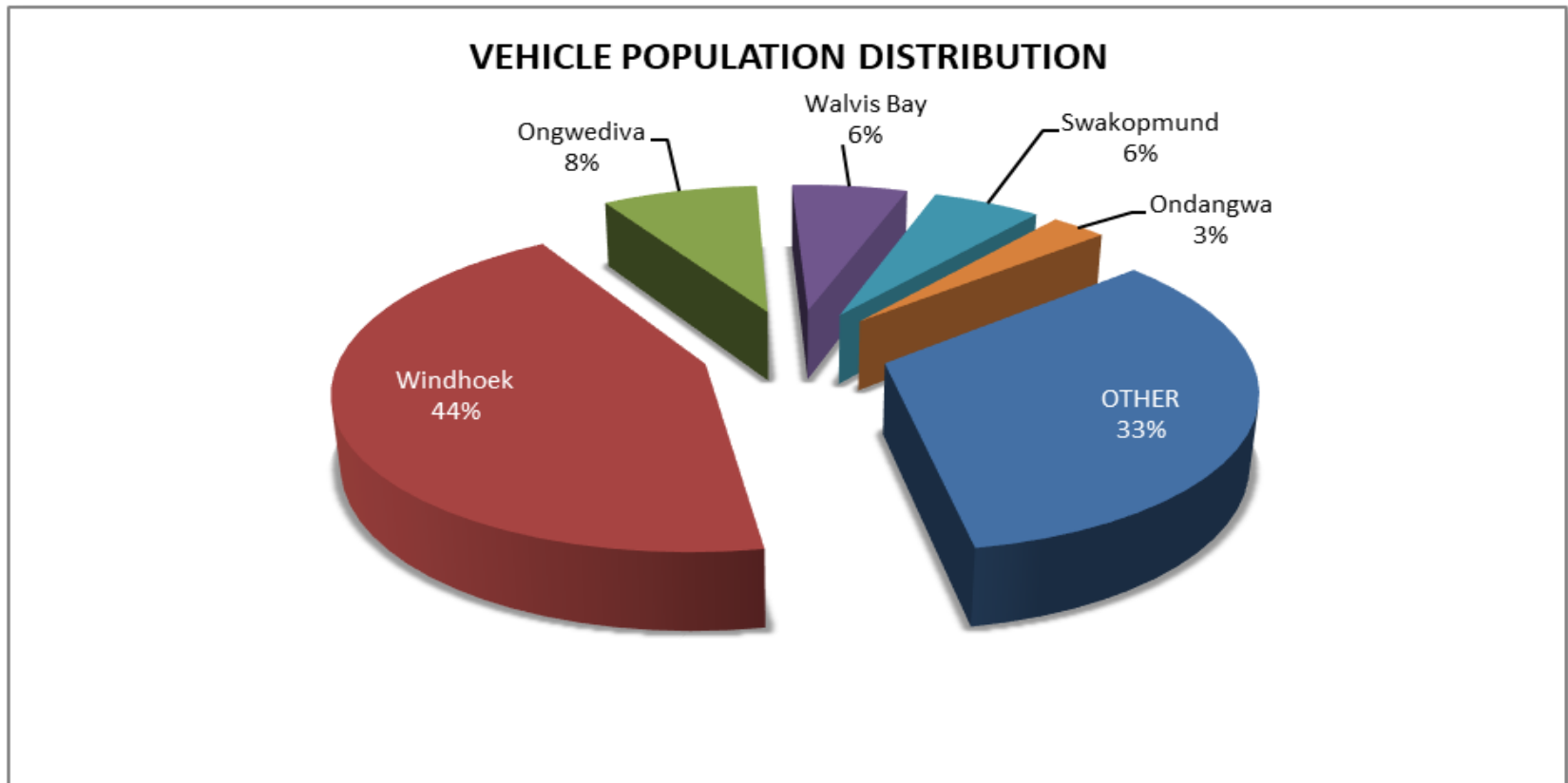

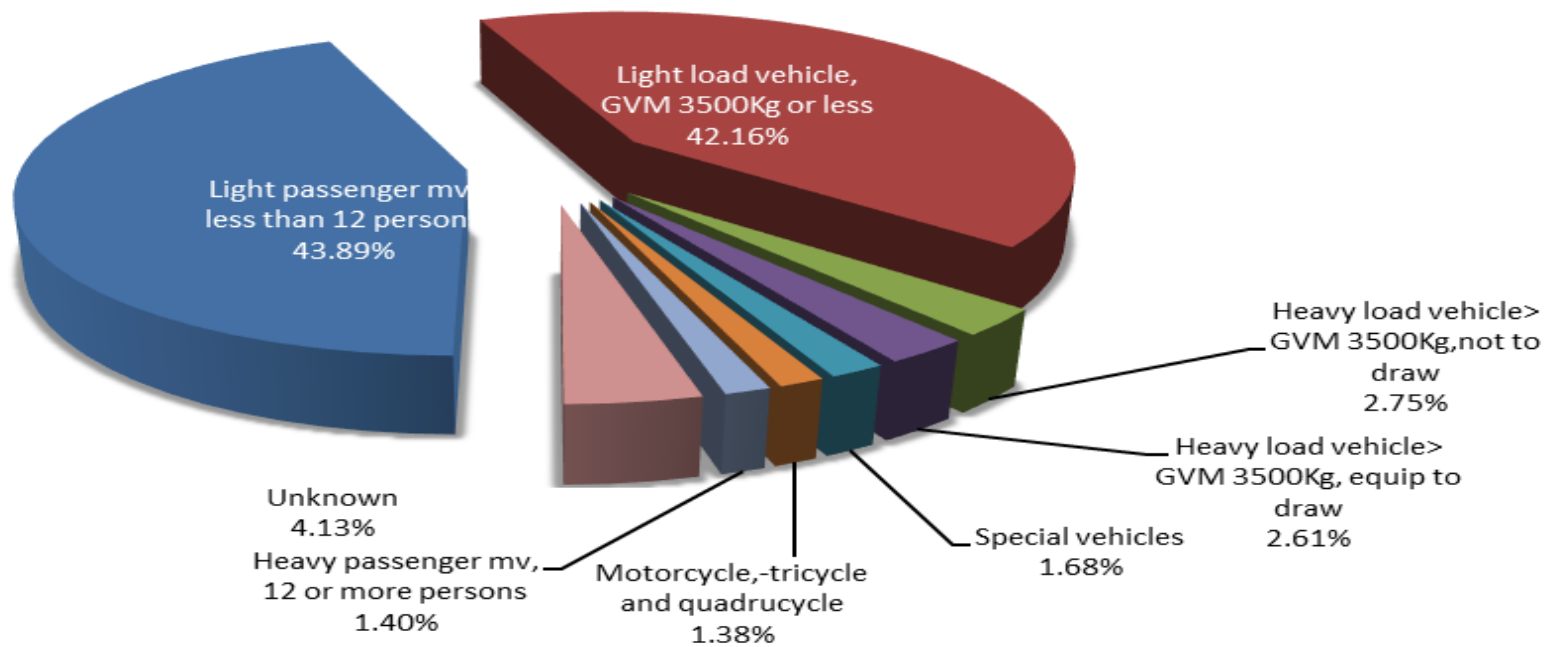
Vehicle Population Distribution
